Exodus 34:27-30. "Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Write these words, for according to the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel.' So [Moses] was there with the Lord forty days and forty night; he neither ate bread nor drank water. And He wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments. Now it was so, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai (and the two tablets of the Testimony were in Moses' hand when he came down from the mountain), that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone while he talked with Him...Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold the skin of his face shone..."



Moses was unaware that his face shone after he had been listening to the Lord for forty days! Moses actually had to hide his face because the people could not look upon him. There was visible evidence of the deposit of God's righteousness that resided within Moses after his encounter.

Interesting that on Moses' first encounter with God the bush was burning, but the second time the *man* was "burning." Neither the bush nor the man was consumed. The bush encounter was a symbol of God's purifying fire and power. Moses became the same: a symbol of God's purifying fire and a powerful agent as well.
